MARRIAGE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

- Must be married in Grundy County. Marriage Licenses issued in Grundy County are not valid in any other county.
- Must be 18 years of age. Both parties need to appear together at the County Clerk's Office.
- ✤ Valid State Driver's License, State I.D., or Passport
- Apply at least one day, but no more than 60 days before marriage.
- If divorced, need a copy of the Judgement of Dissolution with the Judge's signature.
- If widowed, need a CERTIFIED COPY (raised seal) if event occurred within the last year. Photocopy if event occurred over one year ago.
- Any documents presented in a foreign language must be accompanied by a certified English translation.
- ***** \$46.00 cash or Credit Card accepted.
- Hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday.
- If you would like to be married in the Grundy County Courthouse; please call the Grundy County Circuit Clerk's Office (815) 941-3259 to schedule an appointment. (The judges do perform marriage ceremonies on Fridays, starting at 1:00 p.m., and only Schedule three (3) ceremonies per Friday.)
